The **UPSKILL+** project has made significant strides in promoting sustainable innovation in agritourism. The curriculum testing phase is well underway, with partners conducting training sessions and gathering valuable feedback to refine the program further.

The platform has been a focal point, with continuous updates to enhance the user experience. FAB'LIM led a discussion on the testing phase, reminding partners about the conditions of testing: each partner has brought together 35 testers who must follow the 9 e-learning modules and test a number of learnings pill (in-depth courses). Feedback from these testers helps us to improve and adapt our training programme. Each partner provided updates on their progress.

It includes various modules covering essential skills and knowledge areas, supported by "Learning Pills" available in multiple languages. Participants can access the platform to complete their training and track their progress through a user-friendly interface.

Key Features

- Training Modules Covering topics from sustainable farming practices to business management.
- Mentor Support Providing guidance and materials for conducting face-to-face training sessions with prospective learners.
- Self-Evaluation Tools and Digital Badges for Knowledge Recognition - Helping participants assess their learning and progress.
- Interactive Map A curated selection of agritourism initiatives in partner countries highlighting best agritourism practices across Europe.
- Multilingual Access Ensuring accessibility for participants across all partner regions.
